

JUDGMENT AND SALVATION

Romans 5:6-14

D. We believe that all men everywhere are lost and face the judgement of God, that Jesus Christ is the only way of salvation, and that for salvation of lost and sinful man, repentance of sin and faith in Jesus Christ results in regeneration by the Holy Spirit.

Luke 24:46-47; John 14:6; Acts 4:12; Rom 3:23; 2 Cor 5:10-11; Eph 1:7;
Eph 2:8-9; Titus 3:4-7; James 1:13:15

In this one statement, there are 5 big, essential points of doctrine:

Lost, without hope (depravity of man)

Judgement of God

Jesus: Savior, substitute

Repentance

Regeneration

Lost, without hope

- Romans 5:12; Romans 3:10-20a, 23; Romans 7:18; Isaiah 64:6

*"Sin is not a splash of mud on man's exterior,
it is a filth generated from within" -Spurgeon*

Judgement of God

*Because we are, by nature, rebellious sinners,
we are in the crosshairs of a holy, just God.*

- Romans 5:9-10

Jesus: Savior, Substitute

- Romans 5:6-11; Romans 3:21-25a; 1 John 2:2; 2 Cor 5:21; Col 2:11-14

Propitiation: Satisfaction, appeasement

- Isaiah 53:11

Repentance

- Luke 24:47; Acts 2:38; Acts 3:19; Is 55:6-7; Acts 11:18; 2 Tim 2:25

Repentance: A turning from sin to Christ.

Godly sorrow for our sin (our rebellion against God that sets us as His enemy) is essential.

It leads us to turn **from** sin **to** faith in the Savior.

Regeneration

- Titus 3:3-7; 2 Corinthians 5:17

At the moment of salvation, the Holy Spirit enters. He is the source of life – He brings life where there was death, He makes us new!
