ONE AWESOME SERMON: AN UNSAVORY SURPRISE

Matthew 7:15-23

False prophets: "Inwardly they are ferocious wolves" Diligence in study Acts 17:11; 2 Tim. 2:15

A warning to all who leave their minds unguarded, saying, "It's not going to hurt me."

Phil. 4:7-8 "The peace of God...will guard your hearts and minds...think on these things"

Rom. 12:2 "be transformed by the renewing of your mind..."

CHECK THEIR FRUIT VS. 16-18

Good trees yield good fruit. Period. No claims to 50 years of dormancy

Good trees CANNOT yield bad fruit. If your life is bearing bad fruit, you'd better check your legitimacy. Check your soil. Check for disease. (Similar to Jesus' instruction that it is out of the overflow of the heart that the mouth speaks. Matt. 12:33-34)

VSS. 19-20

The bad trees (those not bearing good fruit) are thrown into the fire (face judgment).

VSS. 21-23

"Not everyone who says, 'Lord, Lord' will enter the Kingdom, but only he who <u>does</u> the will of My Father"

Once again, fruit

Note: God is not fooled by churchy words

Also note: Calling Him 'Lord' doesn't mean He is my Lord. Submission to His lordship makes Him your Lord

There will be a lot of surprised people on that Day.

"We implore you on Christ's behalf: be reconciled to God. God made Him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God. As God fellow workers we urge you not to receive God's grace in vain. For He says, 'In the time of my favor I heard you, and in the day of salvation I helped you.
