Hello, Church!

We have so many new families here at Mohican and we are grateful to God for bringing you here! We wanted to take a moment to provide some information on a vital ministry to our community, housed right within these walls.

Back in July 2010, our church established Grocery Bag Ministry (commonly referred to as "GBM"). On the 3rd Thursday of each month, we open our doors to anyone in the community to provide them with groceries and a meal. It is our desire to feed the hungry, both in body & soul; for that reason, the Word of God is also shared at each distribution. The team has changed over the last 15 years, but God has always been the reason for why we give to those in need in our community.

Since the ministry began, the team has purchased all of the groceries rather than going through a larger food bank. This has been solely possible because of God & donations given by gracious members of our church & community. Donations come in all forms: canned food from food drives, monetary and meat (venison included!) from commercial processors.

Lately, we have noticed our savings account quickly decreasing in funds, primarily due to the increase in grocery prices. GBM is not a budgeted line item for Mohican's funds; this means we do not receive any Mohican funding unless your offering is specifically noted for GBM (memo line notation on your check, written on your offering envelope, or selected in tithe.ly online).

GBM began as a ministry to honor Christ and give as He told us to give. We will continue to do so until funding runs out. We covet your prayers for this ministry as we know God has plans and sees things that we cannot see. His plan is greater than anything we can imagine and we are truly grateful for that!
