El Elyon (Heb.) God Most High, Creator and Possessor of Heaven and Earth

First in Gen 14, but more than 200 times in the OT

El Shaddai (Heb.) Lord God Almighty

First in Gen. 17, but nearly 50 uses in the OT
(often as 'the Almighty.')
